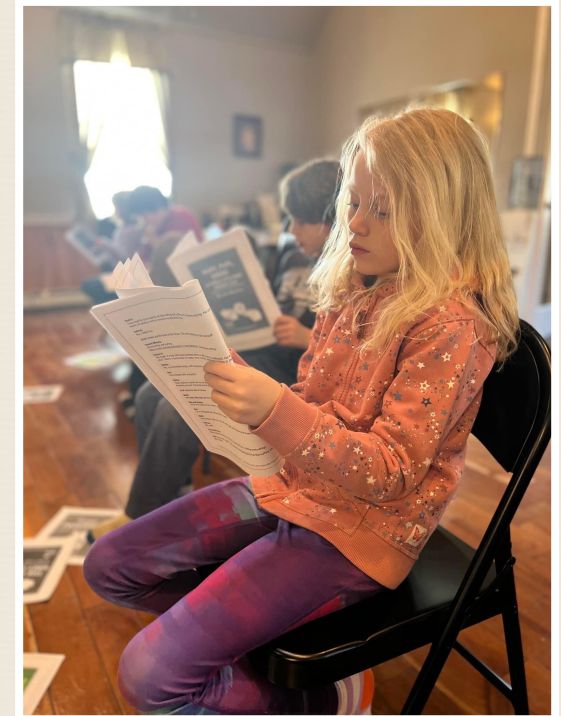
Studio 48 Performing Arts Center

Monday 9AM-3 PM. Accelerando FAP: (Ages: 12+). Mezzo FAP (Ages: 8-11).

Tuesday. 9-11:30 AM "Poco Poco" FAP. Ages 3-7 (separated into two groups)

Wednesday. 9:30-11:30 AM. Ages 6-8. "Shooting Stars" Theater and Dance

Thursday 9:30- 12noon. Ages: 9-14. Dance Theater. Friday. 9:30 AM-3:00 PM. Ages 8+ Performance Class

MONDAY. FAP (9AM-3PM) \$220.00 MONTHLY

Accelerando, a musical term meaning accelerate ages 12+, and Mezzo, meaning middle, ages 8-11 will meet on Monday's 9 AM-3:00 PM. The two groups will be separated and will alternate in dance, music, art, writing, and ensemble performance.

Starts January 30, 2023 and ends May 22, 2023

WEDNESDAY FAP (9:00-11:30AM) \$140 MONTHLY

"Shooting Stars" Ages 6-8 will explore the world of dance, theater and song. There are only 12 slots available. Students will learn vocal techniques in theater voice and singing, dance styles, beginning dance techniques, theater terms and basic acting skills.

Starts March 8, 2023 and ends June 3, 2023

FRIDAY FAP (9AM-3PM). \$220 MONTHLY

Performance Class, ages 8-17. This class is designed for individuals to concentrate on their strengths in music, dance, songwriting, voice, ensemble work, writing scripts, and film. Students will be able to write their show and perform, write a script for film and produce, write a song and perform and create a dance collaboratively.

TUESDAY. FAP (9-11:30 AM). \$140 MONTHLY

"Poco Poco" a musical term meaning little by little is for ages 3-7 years old. Children will be separated into two groups and will learn fundamentals of music, dance, and acting through storytelling.

Starts March 7, 2023 and ends June 2, 2023

THURSDAY FAP (9-11:30 AM). \$140 MONTHLY

Dance Theater for ages 9-14, is a class concentrating on dance, and scenes leading into a dance number. Students will learn dance technique for Broadway shows, and Disney shows. Students will learn character development in dance and acting. There is limited space with only 12 slots available.

Starts March 9, 2023 and ends June 4, 2023
